

Tournament Pitching Rules

Inning Limitations

- **10U–12U:** Maximum of **6 innings pitched in one day** and **8 innings pitched for the tournament**
- **13U–14U:** Maximum of **7 innings pitched in one day** and **8 innings pitched for the tournament**
- **15U–16U:** Maximum of **8 innings pitched in one day** and **9 innings pitched for the tournament**

A player who pitches more than three (3) innings in a single day must rest the following day.

Pitching Limitations by Age Division

The following pitching limitations will be enforced for this tournament:

- **10U:** Maximum of **75 pitches per day**
- **12U:** Maximum of **85 pitches per day**
- **14U:** Maximum of **95 pitches per day**
- **16U:** Maximum of **95 pitches per day**

Mandatory Rest Requirement

Any pitcher who reaches their maximum daily pitch count is automatically ineligible to pitch the following day and is required to take a mandatory rest day.

Pitchers may not pitch 3 consecutive days in a row!

Official Pitching Definition

Once a player is listed on the official lineup card as a pitcher or is announced during a pitching change, that appearance will count as a full inning pitched regardless of the number of outs recorded or pitches thrown during that inning.

This rule applies to every inning pitched during the game. Any partial inning pitched will be recorded as a full inning toward the pitcher's daily and tournament inning limits.

Pitching Violations

Violation of any pitching rule will result in:

- Immediate removal of the pitcher from the mound
- Ejection of the manager from the game
- Suspension of the manager for the team's next scheduled game

A second pitching violation by the same team during the tournament may result in forfeiture of the game.

Pitch Tracking

Teams are responsible for tracking both their own pitchers and opposing pitchers throughout the tournament. The official scorekeeper, provided by FABC, will track pitch counts, it is each team's responsibility to verify pitch count and scores.

Additional Pitching Rules

- Once removed from the mound, a pitcher may not return to pitch in the same game.
- Tournament officials reserve the right to review and enforce all pitching limitations and rest requirements at any time.
